




- 1. Humans in positions of high authority, especially church leaders (e.g. apostles like Peter)

- 3. Evil angelic beings





Pleasure (Hedone): Three Biblical Images

Conflict: "What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your <u>desires</u> that battle within you?"

James 4:1

Slavery: "At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and *pleasures*."

Titus 3:3

Thorns: "The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who

hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and *pleasures*, and they do not mature."


