True Freedom


"You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love." Galatians 5:13

Speech	Amoral; crude and cruel	Eph. 4 – build up others
Modesty	Repressive of self-express	1 Tim. 2 – focus on God
Identity	Found within self	Found within Jesus

έπίγνωσις epignosis

"Personal recognition — coming to understand something clearly and distinctly or as true and valid; often with a personal acquaintance that necessitates a positive or negative reaction."

Logos Bible Lexicon

Used in 2 Peter 1:2,3,8 to refer to personal knowledge of Jesus
